While you're welcome to become a volunteer and get involved with the build, you can help simply by becoming a Supporter of the Project. We currently offer three different levels of subscription:

### SILVER

In return for an annual donation of just £15 per year (reduced to £10 for existing GWS members) and you'll receive a regular newsletter by e-mail to keep you up to date with the very latest progress on the locomotive. You'll also receive invitations to our annual 'Supporters' Days' at Llangollen and Didcot and be eligible to help out with Project activities, including work on the build itself.

### GOLD

Our 'Gold' Supporter's subscription offers all the benefits of our 'Silver' membership, plus you'll receive an invitation to the locomotive's official launch, a footplate ride on No. 4709 and tickets for one of its very first trains on a heritage line. Further benefits will be announced in due course. Gold subscription requires a donation of just £10 per month, payable by standing order, and to be eligible for all the above benefits a minimum subscription of 60 months is required.

### PLATINUM

Our 'Platinum' Supporter's subscription offers all the benefits of our 'Gold' membership, plus you'll receive tickets for No. 4709's inaugural main line train, an opportunity to drive the locomotive at Didcot under supervision and tickets for one day per year to visit No. 4709 at Didcot. Platinum subscription requires a donation of just £25 per month, payable by standing order, and to be eligible for all the above benefits a minimum subscription of 60 months is required.
